SMS EXCEL

Unique Research Work carried out at SMS Institute of Technology

Prof Bharat Raj Singh, Associate Director SMS IT has conceptually designed a new, cleaner motorcycle engine that uses compressed air to turn a small air turbine, generating enough power to run a motorcycle for up to 40 minutes. Their design, described in a recent issue of the Journal of Renewable and Sustainable Energy in USA could be combined with a compressed air cylinder as a replacement for traditional internal combustion engines.

According to Prof BR Singh some 50 to 60 percent of present emissions in some areas could be reduced with the new technology, The article, "Study of the influence of vane angle on shaft output of a multi-vane air turbine" by Bharat Raj Singh and Onkar Singh was published May 6, 2010 in the Journal of Renewable and Sustainable Energy. This article has been praised and given appreciation in the world media which includes USA, Britain, Pakistan, India etc.
